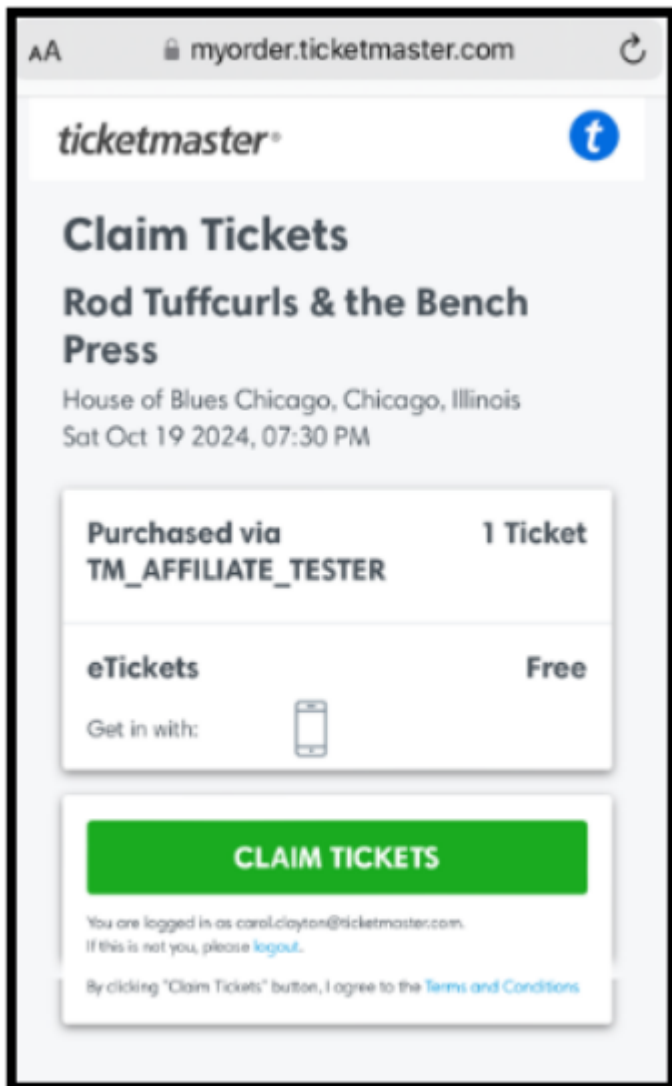


1) Broadway Inbound will send you an email with the tickets (with the order code and product) from yourtickets@broadwayinbound.com

The e-mail will contain instructions and a link to the Ticketmaster URL to obtain the tickets. You'll also receive a verification e-mail with the same link directly from Ticketmaster.

2) After clicking on the link in the request e-mail, you'll be taken to the request page, which looks as follows:



3) Once you have clicked on the request link, you'll be asked to log into your Ticketmaster account or create one. The ticket can be retrieved using any existing Ticketmaster account or any email address to create a new account.

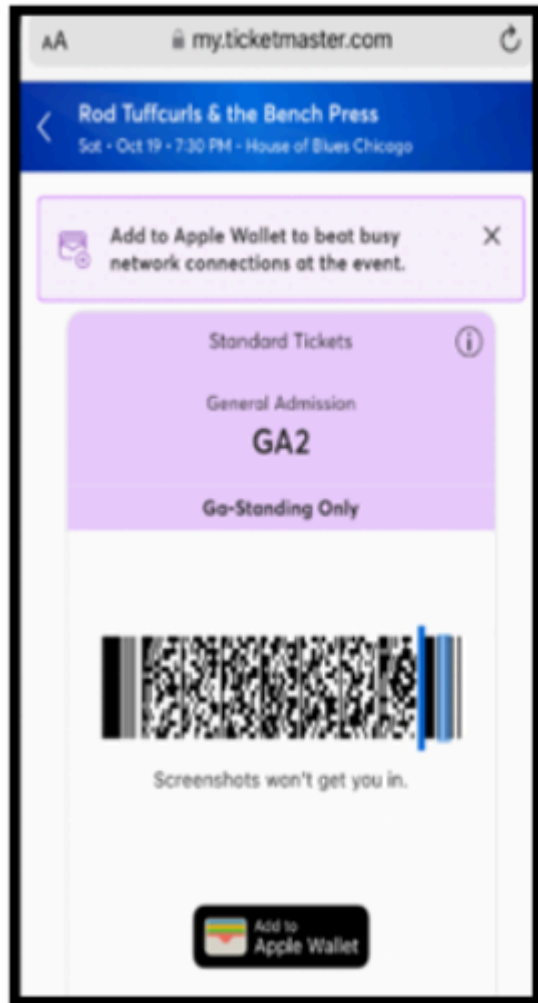
