

What you need to know about your Tallinn Card!

The **Tallinn Card** gives you **free** admission to **museums and sights**, unlimited access to Tallinn's **public transport** and other discounts. **Tallinn Card PLUS** grants you the additional advantage of **free Tallinn City Tour** 🚌.

1 The plastic Tallinn Card is **valid for 24, 48 or 72 hours** from the first time you use it and only when supplied with date and type of the card in the space provided.

2 The mobile Tallinn Card is **valid for 24, 48 or 72 hours** from the first time you use it and only in the period **indicated on the ticket**.

3 The **Tallinn Card does not include free tour**. With **Tallinn Card PLUS** you get free entry to the Tallinn City Tour 🚌.


4 **Always check opening hours and dates on tallinncard.ee**. Note that most museums are closed on **Mon, Tue** and on **public holidays**.


