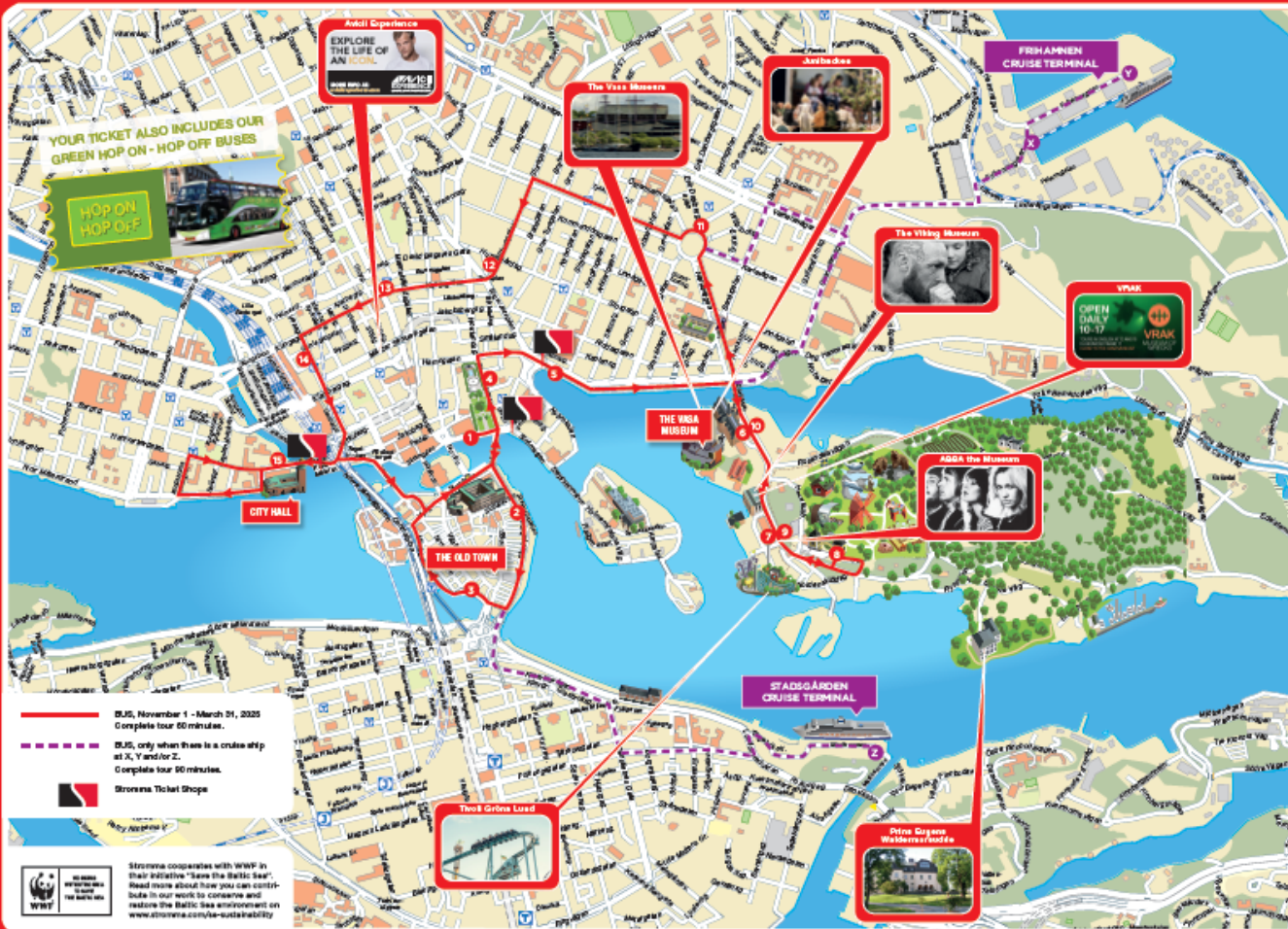

Hop On - Hop Off Bus SIGHTS AND STOPS

- STRÖMGATAN/THE ROYAL OPERA**
The departure point for the tour. Surrounded by some of the most beautiful, historic buildings in Stockholm.
- THE ROYAL PALACE**
The Royal Palace is a combination of the royal residence and the royal workplace. The cultural and historical monuments are open for visitors. Hop off here to see the daily changing of the guard!
- OLD TOWN**
The bustling Old Town is an island with cobbled streets and colorful buildings from the 17th and 18th centuries. Small boutiques, nice restaurants, cafes, and old-style pubs are interspersed with chic cocktail bars. Here you can visit the Nobel Prize Museum.
- KLINGSTRÅDGÅRDEN/SHOPPING DISTRICT**
The park is a favorite area for outdoor lunch and events and close to the top department stores.
- STRANDVÄGEN**
Shopping district with exclusive restaurants. Departure point for excursions and dining cruises in the archipelago.
- THE VASA MUSEUM/NORDISKA MUSEET**
The Vasa Museum with the world's only surviving 17th-century ship. Other museums in the area: Nordiska museet and Junibacken (Astrid Lindgrén).
- ABBA THE MUSEUM/GRÖNA LUND TIVOLI**
The perfect place to find out more about Sweden's most famous band and our rich music history. Or experience a true Swedish amusement park, with rides to thrill and excite.
- SKANSEN**
Stockholm's open-air museum with both countryside houses and town quarters gathered from all of Sweden dated to the mid-19th century. Also a zoo with both Swedish and foreign animals. Don't miss the tropical aquarium.
- KARLAPLAN**
Karlapan square is located in the middle of Stockholm's most exclusive area.
- STUREPLAN ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT**
Where the high class like to mingle and party the night away! Great restaurants and clubs are within a short walk from each other.
- KLINGSGATAN/HÖTORGET MARKET PLACE**
Hötorget square in the center of town is known for its colorful vegetable and flower market and is located next to Stockholm's most famous market hall Hötorgetshallen in the middle of the shopping district.
- ICE BAR**
Experience Stockholm's coolest bar! The temperature is -5 °C all year round. Nearby is Stockholm's international casino - Casino Cosmopol.
- CITY HALL**
Home of the Nobel Prize dinner, this beautiful building attracts around 400,000 visitors and holds the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm.
- FRIHAMNEN/CRUISE TERMINAL 634**
Included in the tour when the ships are in port. Ask the Staff if/when the bus goes to Frihamnen.
- FRIHAMNEN/CRUISE TERMINAL 636**
Included in the tour when the ships are in port. Ask the Staff if/when the bus goes to Frihamnen.
- STADSGÅRDEN CRUISE TERMINAL**
Included in the tour when the ships are in port. Ask the Staff if/when the bus goes to Stadsgården.

Please note which side of the street the bus departs by looking at the signs. We reserve the right to take alternative routes in the event of technical problems or roads being closed.

You must carry a valid ticket at all times. Ticket controls might take place. Tickets are non-refundable.
